



***Maple Leaf Junior Golf Tour awards additional \$4,000 in scholarships;
MJT Cleveland Golf Players of the Year announced***

All my life I have imagined playing golf at the university level. Now, because of the generosity of this scholarship and the opportunities it will provide, my dreams of pursuing golf are one step closer to becoming a reality. I am so, so thankful!" Williams, who plays out of Pinebrook Golf and Country Club, said, "Thank you for the great news - I am honored to have been selected as a joint runner-up for the MJT Cleveland Golf Canada Scholarship. I appreciate the efforts of the MJT to assist me in achieving my college golf ambitions. Regarding the **2011 MJT Cleveland Golf Players of the Year**, four juniors were recognized based on their scoring averages in a required minimum number of MJT tournaments in their respective age group across the country.

The Boys 13 and under MJT Cleveland Golf Player of the Year is **Roy Kang** of North Vancouver, British Columbia, a junior member at Pitt Meadows Golf Club. Boys 14-16 MJT Cleveland Golf Player of the Year is **Matt Williams** of Calgary, Alberta, who has enjoyed a stellar year of junior golf on the MJT. **Jerry Christiansen** of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, a MJT veteran and top performer, is the MJT Cleveland Golf Player of the Year for Boys 17-19 across Canada. Christiansen is currently attempting to qualify for the Canadian Tour at the Desert Dunes Classic in Palm Springs, CA, USA. The national Girls Player of the Year title goes to **Alix Kong** of Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, who has competed on the MJT for the past seven years. Each player receives equipment from Cleveland Golf, one of the founding sponsors of the MJT.
