Junior Member bestows Maple Leaf Junior Golf Tour with ANA Inspiration Grant

Vancouver, BC – (February 13, 2018) – Canada's top female Junior Golfer, Susan Xiao, 16, of Surrey, British Columbia, has selected the Maple Leaf Junior Golf Tour (MJT) to receive the ANA (All Nippon Airways) Inspiration's Gateway City Grant for 2018, helping to launch the 20th season of Canada's number one played Junior Golf Tour on a high note.
